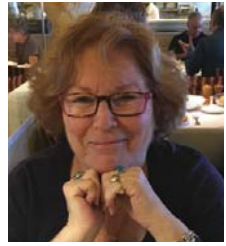

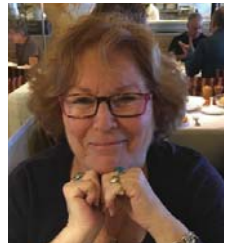

SUPPLY LIST



- Acrylic Paint – Assorted colors (be sure to include black, white, red, blue, yellow)
My favorite: GOLDEN FLUID and HIGH FLOW
- Ink - 2-3 colors plus Black
My favorite: Bombay India inks
- Brushes- assorted, INCLUDE 1 FLAT Flow Brush 2” wide, 3” (optional)
My favorite: Lowell-Cornell
or Robert Simmons Sky Flow Wash
- Mark Making Tools: Pigma MICRON pens, graphite sticks, crayons, colored pencils, pastels, chalk, etc.
- SpectraFix Degas spray fixative
- White Gesso
My Favorite: Utrecht Professional Heavy
or Golden Heavy
- 2 full sheets 300 Lb Cold Press Watercolor Paper - one cut into 6 pieces and one full sheet gessoed prior to class
- Golden POLYMER Mat Medium
- Assorted collage materials (if desired)
- Assorted Stencils
- Sponge brushes
- Paper towels (my favorite: Home Depot Blue Shop Towels)
- Rulers/scissors/drawing pencils/ rubber gloves
