## - Paints

1. Daniel Smith Quin. Gold or New Gamboge
2. Quin. Rose or Permanent Rose
3. Ultramarine Blue
4. Pthalo Blue (gs) or Peacock Blue
5. Indigo

- Covered palette with large mixing areas and paint arranged in the above color order.

- Spray bottle

- Arches Watercolor paper 140# cp 11 x 15 (¼ of a full sheet)

- Brushes-- • 1" flat brush • #6, #10 or #12 Round (Loew Cornell #7020 or Princeton Velvetouch Long Rounds)

- Pencil & kneaded eraser

- Masking tape

- Paper support (Cor-Plast lightweight, waterproof board)
