SUPPLY LIST

Jacquard silk paints (heat-set by iron)

Many wonderful colors to chose from . Please include Sun yellow ,Sulfur green , brilliant red, 2 shades of blue, golden yellow, white, one pink, and any other shades that are your favorite colors.

- Water based resist
- Resist bottle applicator and metal tip size#5
- Various round and flat brushes include # 1,2 ,6,12
- One or two flat brushes 1/2, 1,2 for washes - soft watercolor or fabric brushes are best
- Plastic tablecloth
- White pallet or ice cube tray to hold liquid paints
- Silk salt
- Paper towels
- Qtips and Kleenex
- Water bucket
- Freezer paper
- Silk scarves , silk squares etc. (A scarf ironed to freezer paper will be provided)
- Auto fade marker to draw image on silk piece

Wear old clothes - paints are permanent and will not wash out.
