- Canvas - your choice (I used 16x20 stretched)
- Assorted Brushes
- Palette knife (bent neck -not flat)
- Palette // palette paper // or paper plates
- Spray water bottle
- Fineline applicator w/ white paint or ink
- Mark makers of choice: Art stix, pencils, watercolor crayons, etc.
- Acrylic mediums for texture (I used glass bead gel + pumice gel)
- Acrylic paints of choice: Should have at least 1 or 2 high flows (Blue + Green if using colors in the sample)
Others can be heavy body

***Optional - Gold mica flake
