Sap green
Ultramarine blue
Turquoise
Verditer blue
Cobalt blue
Mineral violet
Rose matter
Brilliant pink
Ultramarine violet

Acrylic Inks –Daler-Rowney FW brand - Have at least one yellow, red & blue (the three primary colors)

Arches 140 Lb cold press paper 1/2 sheet or 1/4 sheet

Water bucket & small spray bottle

Tissues/Viva towels

Original Mr. Clean Magic Eraser

Watercolor pencils (primary colors) & sharpener

Artist tape and support board for paper

Brushes – Loew-Cornell 7020 series # 12, 14, 6, 8, & 1" flat or similar quality.
